## Workshop 1 : Beginner's Patchwork -

### Stack 'n Slash Quilt

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> October

10am – 5pm

Learn how to make a quilt top in a day with this great technique – learn the basics of cutting and piecing with this 'no fail' quilt. Pattern, materials and cutting equipment provided. Bring your machine, sewing thread and lunch.



## Workshop 2 : Disappearing 9 Patch

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> October

10am – 12noon

Take a basic 9 patch block and turn it into something special. Pattern, materials and cutting equipment provided. Bring your machine, cutting equipment and sewing thread. Suitable for those who know the basics and who would like another quick and fun technique to add to their repertoire.



## Workshop 3 : Hyperbolic Crochet

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> October

10am – 1pm

Learn the amazing technique of 'Hyperbolic Crochet' – such great fun. See how to create stunning works of art or use them to embellish hats, quilts, bags or anything you can think of. Bring your crochet hooks of all sizes; we have the wool for you to play with. Patterns provided.



### Workshop 4 : Scrumbling Knitting

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> October

2pm – 5pm

Learn the amazing technique of 'Scrumbling' knitting – such great fun. See how to create stunning bags, clothing, wearable art and so much more with this free form knitting technique. We have the knitting needles and the wool – learn the basics in this workshop.

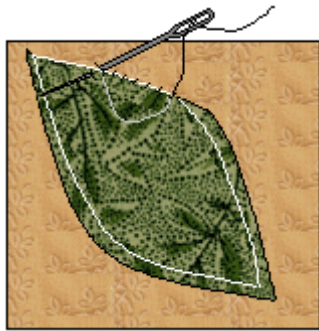


### Workshop 5 : Mitred corners

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> October

1pm – 3pm

Mitred corners – you may not know how easy they can be. Learn this technique and practise on this Attic Windows Quilt. For quilters with some experience. Bring a fat quarter of a large floral or scenic print; a fat quarter of light fabric for the bottom of the window and a dark fat quarter for the side of the window. The sashing and borders can be finished in the workshop or at home.



### Workshop 6 : Needle turn Appliqué

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> October

1pm – 3pm

There are many, many techniques to do needle turn appliqué and we are going to investigate many of these in this workshop. The aim is to find the technique that suits you and to learn the appliqué stitch. All materials provided.



### Workshop 7: Strip Quilt – the Fast and the Spectacular

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> October

3pm – 5pm

This technique is brilliant for fast, fast quilt tops – great for Charity quilts and for using Jelly Rolls. You won't believe how good this one is. Materials provided for a smaller version so that we can get results in the 2 hours. Bring your sewing machine with thread and lots of bobbins ready to go. Any colour thread – use up what you have.



### Workshop 8: Candlewicking for Beginners

Learn the beautiful craft of Candlewicking in this introductory workshop. All equipment and kits provided. If you've always wanted to try Candlewicking, this is the workshop for you.
